Tour Director Update

Welcome to the final newsletter before we welcome you in person at the Griffith Pioneer Park Museum, 40 Remembrance Drive Griffith. You should be able to get a map at your park or



accommodation with directions to the Museum.

The Pioneer Park Museum will be open for entrants to drive their vehicles into between 8.30 am and 10.00am. At 10.00am the Museum is open to the public and the vehicle access gate will be closed. We have arranged for a small number of vehicles to be allowed to enter at either 11.00 or 12.00am under guidance from the Tour committee. There will be no further Veteran Vehicle entrance after 12.00noon. However, you will be able to enter via the normal entry to the Museum and let them know that you are a participant of the Tour.

The registration desk will be open from 10.00am until 2.30PM to collect your tour information and instructions.

Coffee and food is available to purchase in the grounds of the Museum.

At 3.00pm the Museum is closed to the public and you will be an officially welcomed by the Mayor and Chairman of the Tour committee followed by a Mayoral Civic Reception. There will be NO entry to the Museum for entrants after 3.00pm.

The Tour book provided at check in has comprehensive instructions on what you need to take each day and how to reach the chosen destination. You are welcome to detour from the Tour route but there will be no signage or backup facility.

There will be a rolling start each day between 8.30 and 9.30am at the Yoogali Club. There is no need to stop or park unless you have a question to ask one of the Tour committee members.




